

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR YOUR POSTER PRESENTATION



Poster presentation

The poster presentation consists in the publication of the abstract on the I.S.Rivers website and the exhibition of a poster during one of the 3 conference days (see online programme).

Poster sessions

A specific exhibition programme will enable the daily presentation of approximately 40 posters. Conference delegates will be able to meet and exchange with poster authors during breaks and lunchtimes. We invite you to stand near your poster during those specific moments, in order to present your work to the interested people and if possible, have a few copies of your poster available in A4 format to give to people.

Best poster competition

For a dynamic meeting and to reward you for your efforts in the preparation of your poster and the information given to visitors, a competition will elect the best poster of the day.

Poster format

Please prepare your poster using the following dimensions: **84.1 cm wide by 118.9 cm high**, equivalent to an **A0 format**.

For all posters to have a consistent layout, please use the PowerPoint template [available here](#) and in the "Submissions" section of the I.S.Rivers website. The template is already in A0 format.

Recommendations: check the quality of pictures by zooming at 100 %.

Language: we invite you to write your poster in English and if possible in both English and French, as simultaneous translation will not be provided during the poster sessions.

Printing and set-up of your poster

You can either bring your poster at the conference and install it as you arrive at the conference venue. We will provide you with the necessary material to install it.

Or, to save you time and work

We offer you the possibility to print your poster for the amount of 35 €.

Between May 30 and June 19, 2025, we will open an order form that will allow you to upload your poster file and pay for printing by card. We'll send you an email with the link when it's open.

Your poster will be printed and kept for you to find it as you arrive at the Lyon 2 University.
